



## **MICHAEL KLEIN**



### **President and Chief Executive Officer IDQ Holdings**

Michael Klein is the president and chief executive officer of IDQ Holdings – the leading packager of value-added products for the mobile air conditioning market. IDQ produces products under the trade names of Interdynamics and Quest/EF Products and is a global supplier as well as the nation's leading retail supplier. He joined IDQ in 2007 and led the merger of Quest/EF Products and Interdynamics and the subsequent facility move to its current headquarters in Garland, Texas where IDQ now employs over 200 people.

Klein was the former chief executive officer of Murray's Discount Auto Stores – the 100+ store chain based out of Belleville, Michigan and now part of O'Reilly Automotive. He was associated with Murray's from 1978 to early 2005 (shortly before the purchase of Murray's by CSK Auto in late 2005). Over the years, he helped Murray's grow from six Detroit-area stores to a chain of 109 auto parts superstores in Michigan, Ohio, Illinois, and Indiana. He served in a variety of executive positions including chief financial officer, chief operating officer, president, chairman of the board, and chief executive officer. During his tenure, Murray's grew to annual revenues of nearly \$250 million and a workforce of over 2,200 employees while competing against nearly 300 competitive outlets.

Klein graduated (with High Distinction) in 1979 from Wayne State University in Detroit and holds a B.S. degree in business administration. Prior to joining Murray's Discount Auto Stores, Klein was a Certified Public Accountant and Certified Financial Planner with the Michigan firm of Gordon & Company.

Klein currently serves on the executive board of trustees of the Leader Dogs for the Blind as well as the executive board and board of directors for the Automotive Aftermarket Industry Association (AAIA). He is also the chairman of the AAIA Investment committee and past chairman of the AAIA's Category Management committee. Klein resides in Dallas, Texas and Bloomfield Township, Michigan with his wife, Sharon, and their three children.
